## "From Snap to WOW! The Ultimate iPhone Photography Workshop!"

## **Materials List**

## Equipment

The best thing about iPhone photography is that you don't need a lot of apps or equipment! And the iPhone's native camera and editor allow for a great deal of creative work just with the features that come with your iPhone.

The two main things you need for this workshop are:

- An iPhone. While later models have more features and capabilities, you can create with any iPhone (See note below about Android Phones.)
- Cables for recharging your iPhone

The following accessories are optional:

- An external battery for recharging in the field (optional)
- A lightweight tripod for long exposures (optional)
- An iPhone bracket for mounting your iPhone on a tripod (optional)
- Attachable lenses (optional)

## Apps

The variety of apps available today is mind-boggling! They range in cost from free, to a few dollars, to more expensive subscription plans. However, it is not necessary to spend a lot on apps for this workshop.

Here is a list of core Apps to install prior to the workshop. Each of these is free or an inexpensive one-time purchase:

- SnapSeed by Google (Free!)
  SnapSeed is a free app that runs on both iPhone and Android. It's extremely powerful and versatile allowing you to edit and stylize your images in countless ways.
- *Image Blender* by JHND I Sverige AB (\$3.99) This iPhone-only app is a staple for creatively combining images
- **Dramatic Black & White**, by JixiPix Software (\$2.99) This app allows creatives to convert color photos to B&W and craft the image with various adjustments for stunning results.

You will be able to do many things with free and inexpensive apps, but you may want to explore some new apps for creative work as well. Be sure to have your password so that you can download apps from the App Store or the Google Play Store. You know you'll want to! Tip: Many subscription apps have a trial period that allows you to work with them for

several days to see if you want to make a long-term commitment. For these apps, you might want to wait to try them until the week of our workshop before purchasing.

Missy, Charles and Rad are constantly discovering new apps and will introduce you to a variety of apps during the workshop including:

- Different camera apps
- Long-exposure apps
- Stylizing apps for adding textures and gels
- Blending apps for creating composites of two or more photos
- Apps for applying painterly effects
- And more!

A Word about the Lightroom Mobile App:

• Lightroom Mobile is a paid subscription app but one of the most powerful and versatile tools available for iPhone and Android. If you already subscribe to the Adobe Creative Cloud to have Lightroom and Photoshop on your desktop, Lightroom Mobile is included in your subscription fee. If you are not a subscriber but would like to be, the cost to subscribe starts at \$9.99/month.

\*Note: Android users are welcome with the understanding that Charles, Missy and Rad all use and will demonstrate various apps and camera features using an iPhone. Many (but not all) apps and techniques work on both iPhones and Androids, and the instructors will highlight similar Android apps when possible.
