Workshop Supply List:

Painting Materials:

• Brushes:

Bring a selection of filberts and flats in varying sizes. Avoid soft synthetic brushes and brights. Recommended brushes:

- Stiff synthetics: Rosemary Ivory series or Silver Brush Bristlon series
- Natural bristle: Robert Simmons, Tintoretto, Silver Brush, or Rosemary Important: Bring at least two brushes that are ¾" and 1" wide.
- Medium: Refined linseed oil (not cold-pressed or stand oil).
- Cleaning Supplies:
 - Odorless mineral spirits for rinsing/cleaning brushes
 - Rags or paper towels
- Palette: A palette at least 11" x 14" or larger.
- Canvas or Panels:
 - Neutrally toned gray canvas or panels (e.g., Liquitex Neutral Gray #5)
 - Size range: 14" x 18" to 16" x 20"
 - Tone your surfaces before class so they are dry and ready to use.
 - Bring 1–2 canvases/panels for each day of the workshop.
- Paint Cups or Cans:
 - Containers for your thinner (at least 3" in diameter).
 - A jar with a lid for used paint thinner.

Oil Colors:

- Titanium White
- Cadmium Red Light (or equivalent)
- Cadmium Orange (or equivalent)
- Burnt Sienna
- Yellow Ochre
- Alizarin Crimson



- Ultramarine Blue
- Purple
- Cadmium Yellow Light
- Viridian Green
- Azo Green (M. Graham recommended)
- Raw Umber
