Don Demers' Workshop Materials List

The workshop is designed primarily for oil painting.

This list is a broad outline for those requesting guidelines. It is not mandatory or complete.

Easel: One of the following:

- 1. French Easel
- 2. Pochade Box
- 3. Portable easel and paint box

Portable seat/stool

Basic palette: (suggestions only)

These are the colors that work for me.

Titanium White, Ultramarine Blue, Cobalt Blue, Viridian, Green Earth (Rembrandt) Sap Green, Cadmium Yellow Light or Lemon, Cadmium Yellow Medium, Yellow Ochre, Raw Sienna, Cadmium Red Light, Cadmium Red Deep, Alizarin Crimson, Burnt Sienna, Burnt Umber, Raw Umber, Greenish Umber (Rembrandt)

Brushes:

A selection of bristle and/or natural hair brushes, sizes ranging from small to large. For brush style, I use filberts, flats and rounds. Badger hair or sable brushes are effective for softening edges. Mid size flats or filberts work best for me.

Painting Medium: Liquin or another medium of your choice

Thinner. Gamsol

Brush Cleaner: Fels Naptha soap or B&J The Masters Brush Cleaner

Canvas: Panels using linen, cotton duck, or polyflex. Sizes: Smaller sizes strongly recommended. Not to exceed 14 x 18.

Miscellaneous:

Neutral color painting shirt, hat and painting umbrella Sketch pad and pencils (I use grey paper with black and white charcoal pencils.
